

## **BHEL MEDICAL EXAMINATION RULES PERTAINING TO EXPERIENCED ENGINEERS**

### **MEDICAL FITNESS**

To be passed as fit for appointment, a candidate must be in good mental health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties of his/her appointment. Candidates having hypertension, epilepsy, diabetes, congenital & acquired physical defects will be considered unfit depending upon the nature of job.

### **VISUAL ACUITY**

It has been mentioned in the recent standards that total myopia (including cylinder) shall not exceed 4.0 O.D. and total hypermetropia (including cylinder) + 4.0 O.D. Candidates with higher power (Higher than -4.0 or +4.0) can be assessed according to the fundus and other ocular findings. If the visual acuity according to the prescribed standard is achieved and ocular condition does not foretell any future deterioration, candidates with high power can be considered.

### **ONE EYED PERSON**

A one eyed person will be considered as unfit for technical jobs.

### **COLOUR VISION**

The testing of colour vision shall be essential for all candidates. Colour vision shall be tested with Ishihara's isochromatic plates in good light. Colour blindness will be disqualification for technical jobs.

### **EAR**

A candidate with hearing loss of ears will be declared medically unfit.
